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**COMPLAINT REGARDING POTENTIAL UNLAWFUL
SURVEILLANCE AND VICTIMISATION FOR OVER 50
YEARS BY THE BRITISH INTELLIGENCE AGENCIES.**

Dear Commissioner

I am writing to formally submit a complaint to the Investigatory Powers Commissioner under the Investigatory Powers Act 2016. I believe that I may have been subject to unlawful surveillance, monitoring, and/or interference with my personal affairs by one or more UK intelligence or law enforcement agencies, namely MI5, MI6, GCHQ, or another body acting under government authority.

SUMMARY OF CONCERNS

I have experienced a number of concerning incidents which have led me to reasonably believe I may have been a target of surveillance or victimisation, including but not limited to:

- The recent unexplained deletion of my student and university employment records from multiple universities, which I attended in the 1970s and 1980s. These include Durham University, Nottingham University and Leeds University. i.e. Is this an attempt to make me “disappear legally?”
- Unusual deletion of emails from my personal accounts, not actioned by me. For example, emails I exchanged with the Director of Intelligence and

Security in Canberra, Australia. Emails exchanged with Trent Zimmerman, local Australian MP for North Sydney. And communications between me and the mining museum in Kemerovo, Russia. I tried to publish a book in Australia about my treatment in UK universities in 2017. A man claiming to be from British Military Intelligence, called “John” who claimed he worked in Berlin in the 1960s in military intelligence and crossed into East Berlin with a film crew shooting a Michael Caine film called “Funeral in Berlin.” He then threatened me and my family with unspecified “fatal consequences” if I published my book. I took the matter up with the MP. I was told by him that “they” had spoken to the people in Britain about me, and told me not to worry because “Everyone knows that what they say about you are utter lies.”

- Pressure from people who live locally and claim to be working for MI6, who threatened me with murder. I successfully took out an apprehended violence order against this person in Wyong Court in 2023.
- Murder attempts in Leeds and Darlington around 1985 when I was at Leeds University. I complained to my local MP Michael Fallon, who told me that “Someone in the civil service had a grudge against me and go home, things will be OK.” A week later he spoke to my aunty who was at a conservative party meeting and said to her, “Tell Michael it has gone too far, tell him to get out of the country.”
- The discovery in 2005 that Professor Donald Durstan Hawkes of Aston University had published papers that he had blatantly plagiarised from my thesis, back in 1984. My PhD was a report for NERC on the potential mineral deposits in the Antarctic Peninsula. This was how the British Government rewards academics who “do their bit for their country.” I also discovered that the British Antarctic Survey has photocopied my PhD in full without my permission. As I wrote to the Director and the head librarian at BAS, this was a breach of copyright. And that without respect for copyright, the academic world would descend into the chaos of plagiarism. The librarian, Christine Phillips, wrote back to me and said my thesis had been destroyed. She said the Deputy Director called Swithenbank, with the assistance of a geologist called John Smellie had undertaken the illegal copying. I believe Mr Smellie is now an advisor to the Royal Society.
- I was subject to a murder attempt by the Russian Mafia when I visited Vostochny sea port in Primorsky region, Vladivostok in 2005. I was rescued by a man from Moscow, who told me the British had paid 50,000 pounds to have me killed. I was sent there by Robert Rounsley, a corporate manager for Dyno Nobel explosives company. In a room at the seaport that had head and shoulders framed photographs in black and white of distinguished looking Russian men and women was a photo of Roger Hollis when he was in his mid to late 30s. And a huge map of Australia 5m by 4m.
- I went to Kemerovo in Siberia in 2011 with the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade. There I discovered that my relatives from Chopwell in County Durham had gone there in 1928 to 1934. In a BBC documentary called “Watching the Russians” Stella Rimmington, the ex Head of MI5, claimed there was a Soviet Spy ring in Chopwell in the cold war.

- I was also told disturbing things about British Royalty by Earnest Kirkby in 1985. Kirkby was a close associate with Professor Maurice Beresford, Leeds University

These experiences over the last 50 years have caused me significant distress and raise concerns about lawful processes were followed, or whether I am being unfairly targeted.

Have I been used as an unwitting pawn by MI5 and MI6?

Or to put the question in a way that even a feral bogan from Condobolin in out back NSW could understand, What the hell has been going on over the last 50 years?

Attach a copy of two books that describe all these weird events and more. "The Devil can be kind to some people," and "A journey of self discovery." They describe in full detail all the things that happened to me. They are published in the USA.

After the man claiming to be from British Military Intelligence threatened me, I received an insulting email from the Director of the British Antarctic Survey in 2017. She described me as a despicable person. Please tell me what I have done to deserve this insult. At that point I renounced my British Citizenship. Three years before that I worked at Chemring explosives plant at Ardeer in Scotland. After I was told that my father's army record at the army historical records office in Glasgow had been shredded, I was summarily dismissed by a woman called Clark who claimed to be the MI5 officer there. Why? When I got back to Australia, the meagre information the historical records office had sent me perviously had mysteriously disappeared.
